2. Oral exam (max 80 points)

a) Candidates who possess a degree obtained in Italy or abroad (with equivalent value) in the field of Medical-Biological, Physics, Engineering disciplines are admitted to the oral exam. During the oral exam, aspects concerning the qualifications presented and previous research activities will be explored and clarified, which can help evaluate the propensity for research and the ability to independently organize the various phases of the project.

b) foreign language
